



Kindergarten Transition

	FALL	 Parents and child explore different schools and programs. If possible, attend Open House Events in the fall with child.
	JAN	□ Select a school of choice.
N E	FEBRUARY	 Parents register their child to the school of their choice. The Consultants for Special Needs and the Consultants for Autism are available to assist the parents as needed. If a child has special needs, the parent indicates it on the registration form and completes the <i>Release of Information-Consent</i> form(s). <i>Release of Information</i> forms and pertinent reports are sent to Student Services. Consultants for Special Needs and other professionals start reviewing student files for their schools.
R O P O S I M E L I	MARCH to JUNE	 Information on strengths and needs of the student is gathered by the Consultant for Special Needs and school team through conversations with parents, other professionals, current educator and observation as needed. A daycare or home observation visit is set-up by the Consultant for Special Needs if needed. Student attends Kindergarten Orientation. An individual visit to the elementary school may be organized at the school level. During the visit, the student is photographed in different settings around the school, the student is introduced to the principal, resource teacher and the student visits the resource room.
_ ⊢	MAY- JUNE	 Social stories are written about school. These social stories are read to the student on a regular basis. Discuss possibilities and needs around locker/cubby location. Resource teacher ensures that required visual supports are prepared.
	JUNE to AUGUST	 School Special Needs Committee is involved with the planning of support for the following year. Parents continue looking over the school photos with the student and continue going over the social stories during the summer. A visit can be scheduled at the end of the August, just prior to the start of the school year.
